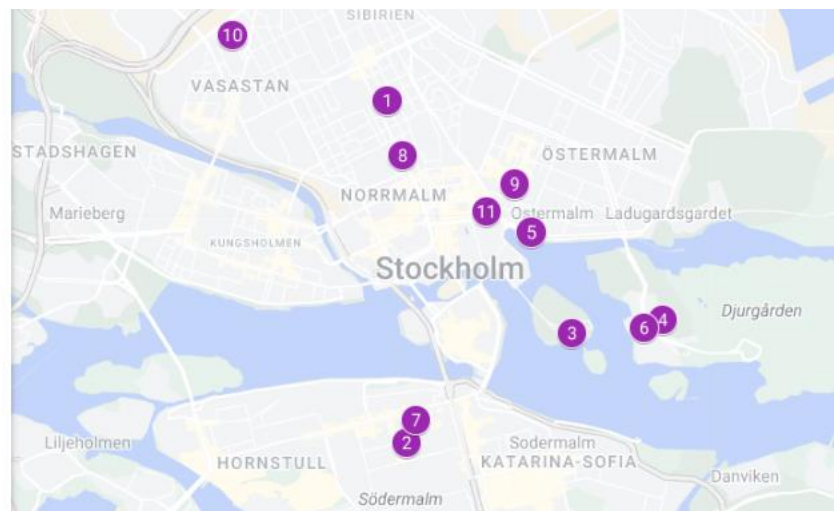

Enjoy a welcome dinner by the lake at Mälarpaviljongen, an iconic welcoming stylish establishment for all but with an LGBT+ mission. This legendary place is beautifully located on the waters of Lake Mälaren, take in the ambience, hear more about their mission, and enjoy the Pride vibe and the delicious food. Mälarpaviljongen was once voted one of the best neighborhood restaurants in the world by Condé Nast Traveler.

Day 2 | Thursday 3 August - Regal Stockholm

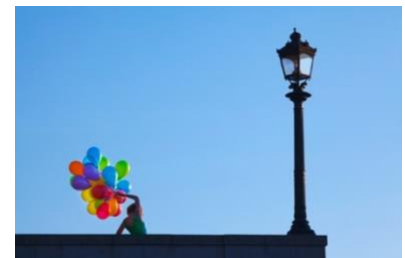

Day 4 | Saturday 5 August – Pride Parade Day



It's Pride Weekend!

Enjoy this Saturday at your own leisure, sleep in, enjoy breakfast in bed, go shopping. Meet up to watch the Pride Parade, or for brunch, drinks or exploring. Use your transportation cards to get around and don't forget to stop by some underground stations with incredible art and rainbow picture moments. The Pride Parade kicks off at 13:00 so you have enough time to explore or meet up for brunch before finding a great spot down the 4.5km road of pure fun, rainbows and happiness in the Stockholm sun or, even more fun, simply join in, because at Stockholm Pride, you can.
