Winter in The Regal North

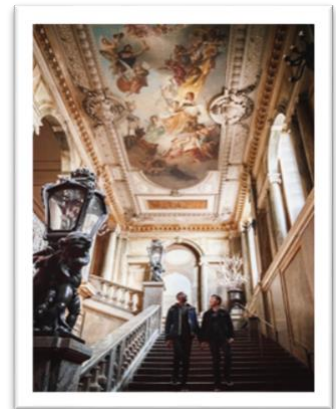
Stockholm is captivating year-round, but truly magical in winter. For the ultimate experience, explore the Arctic North to deepen your love for this enchanting city. Discover a capital of islands linked by romantic bridges and enjoy a warm welcome to an open and inviting destination. Välkommen.

Day 1 | Stockholm Arrival

Upon arrival, we'll greet and assist you to your hotel. The city center is only 20 minutes away via the [Arlanda Express](#) train or 40 minutes by car. Our fast-track VIP service is also available.

Stay at one of [Stockholm LGBT+ partner hotels](#), each ideally situated in the heart of the city to suit your style, budget, and preferences. Explore the selection for more choices.

Explore with a guide or on your own, start in the charming Old Town. Wander through winding streets, cozy cafés and visit the Christmas market in Gamla Stan. Discover the Stockholm [Royal Palace](#) or take a trip to the countryside to [Drottningholm Palace](#) for more exquisite interiors and endless tales of royal love stories, culture and history.



Enjoy lunch at [Gondolen](#) with stunning city views. The evening is followed by drinks at the chic [Teatergrillen](#) and dinner at [Villa Dagmar](#), a stylish boutique hotel.

Day 2 | Royal Djurgården & City

Start your day with a cozy breakfast at [Hotel Skeppsholmen](#) before taking the ferry to [Royal Djurgården](#), a national park offering nature, recreation, and culture. Visit the [Vasa Museum](#) to see the impressive 17th-century warship, salvaged nearly perfectly after sinking on its maiden voyage. Enjoy the interactive [ABBA Museum](#), then savor a late lunch at Riche.

Spend the afternoon shopping for Scandinavian design in the style district. Begin your evening with pre-dinner drinks at La Belle Epoque, [Hotel Kung Carl](#)'s chic bistro and bar, or at [Miss Clara](#), a design hotel featuring a lively brasserie and even a pizzeria.



Day 3 | Stockholm North & South

Spend your day exploring the North and the evening in the South of Stockholm. Start with morning shopping and exploration, then retreat to the stylish oasis of hotel [Ett Hem](#) for a delightful lunch in stunning surroundings. Enjoy an afternoon aperitivo or coffee at [Nobis Hotel](#)'s Gold Bar before continuing your shopping.

In the evening, take a cocktail class and enjoy drinks at the trendy bohemian [Hellstens Glashus](#). For dinner, savor a variety of flavors at some of our favorite restaurants. Explore Södermalm's trendy spots, starting with breakfast at [Hotel Rival](#), followed by lunch at [The Hills](#), and finish with dessert and gorgeous views at [Café Klotet](#).



Day 4-5 | Arctic Lapland & Depart

Just a 1.5-hour flight from Stockholm takes you to Kiruna, home to the Ice Hotel, or a 1 hour and 15-minute flight to Luleå, near the unique Arctic Bath and Treehotel. Enjoy a magical husky ride or hunt for the Aurora Borealis while dining under the stars.



Immerse yourself in the Sámi culture of Swedish Lapland, exploring their traditions, reindeer herding practices, and deep Arctic connection. Try ice fishing, snowshoeing, or a moose safari before your transfer to the airport.
